Prof Takashi Inoguchi is Professor Emeritus, University of Tokyo and President, University of Niigata Prefecture. He is also former Assistant Secretary General of the United Nations assigned to The United Nations University Headquarters. He has B.A. and M.A. degrees from University of Tokyo and a Ph.D. from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). He has published more than 100 books and numerous articles on a broad range of subjects. For the last decade he has executed large scale random sampled nation-wide surveys in all the Asian countries and societies (i.e., in East, Southeast, South and Central Asia, except for the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and Timor Leste) focusing on quality of life and well-being with 60 thousand respondents and 6 million observations. he has published with co-author Seiji Fujii *The Quality of Life in Asia: A Comparison of Quality of Life in 29 Asian Countries and Societies* and with Doh Chull Shin as co-editor *The Quality of Life in Confucian Asia: From Physical Welfare to Subjective Well-Being*. Other recent publications written by Prof. Inoguchi include: *Values and Life Styles in Urban Asia*, Mexico City; (coedited with Miguel Basanez et al.); *Political Cultures in Asia and Western Europe* (coauthored with Jean Blondel); *Citizens and the State* (coauthored with Jean Blondel); and, *Globalization, Public Opinion and the State* (coedited with Ian Marsh). On Japan and international affairs, he has published, among others, *The Political Economy of Japan* (coedited with Daniel Okimoto), *American Democracy Promotion* (coedited with Michael Cox and G. John Ikenberry) and, *Japanese Politics: An Introduction*.

Dr. Inoguchi is a member of the Science Council of Japan, Founding Editor of the *The Japanese Journal of Political Science* and the *Journal of International Relations of the Asia Pacific*. He also is Director of the *AsiaBarometer Project* and is Chairman of the *Asian Consortium for Political Research*.
